**1) THE GREATNESS OF GOD**

**Rom. 1:19-20** (NLT) – *They know the truth about God because he has made it obvious to them. For ever since the world was created, people have seen the earth and sky. Through everything God made, they can clearly see his invisible qualities—his eternal power and divine nature. So they have no excuse for not knowing God.*

- Even unbelievers know about God's \_\_\_\_\_

**1 John 4:17** (NKJV) – *Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because as He is, so are we in this world.*

**2 Peter 1:4** (NLT) – *And because of his glory and excellence, he has given us great and precious promises. These are the promises that enable you to share his divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human desires*

- **Q. Do we see a significant difference between God's people and the world?**

**Daniel 6:3-4** (NKJV) – *“Daniel distinguished himself above the governors and satraps, because an excellent spirit was in him; and the king gave thought to setting him over the whole realm. <sup>4</sup> So the governors and satraps sought to find some charge against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find no charge or fault, because he was faithful; nor was there any error or fault found in him.*

**1 Kings 4:25** (NLT) – *During the lifetime of Solomon, all of Judah and Israel lived in peace and safety. And from Dan in the north to Beersheba in the south, each family had its own home and garden.*

**Hebrews 8:6** (NKJV) - *...He (Jesus) is also Mediator of a better covenant which has established better promises.*

**Acts 17:26** (NKJV) - *These who have turned the world upset down.*

**Acts 4:33-34** (NLT) - *The apostles testified powerfully to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and God's great blessing was upon them all. <sup>34</sup> There were no needy people among them, because those who owned land or houses would sell them*

**Acts 10:26** (NKJV) – *Stand up; I am also a man.*

**Acts 14:14-15** (MSG) – *What do you think you are doing! We are not gods!*

**Acts 28:3-6** (MSG) - *Paul ...gathered up a bundle of sticks... (and) a venomous snake... struck his hand and held on. The natives... kept expecting him to drop dead, but when it was obvious he wasn't going to, they jumped to the conclusion that he was a god!*

**Acts 19:9-10** (NKJV) - *(Paul)... withdrew the disciples, reasoning daily in the school of Tyrannus. And this continued for two years, so that all who dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.*

**1 John 2:6** - *Those who say they live in God should live their lives as Jesus did.*

## II. DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1) You won't be motivated to tap into any potential you are unaware of. How have you seen this principle to be true in your life? What new products, technologies, or beliefs have you embraced after you found out what they could do for you?
  - How is this similar to what you learned in this lesson?
  
- 2) Our potential in God includes nearly unimaginable possibilities. How did this lesson inspire you to explore the potential of your identity in Christ? What are some areas where you've been thinking too small?
  
- 3) Why do you think our potential in Christ is not commonly taught in churches today? Or, if it is taught, it's merely as positive thinking, not by depending on an almighty God?
  - How do you think the church would change if we were taught to believe all is possible? As you meditate on the possibilities, how are you beginning to change you?
  
- 4) When we fall so short of what we as Christians could be, it affects how the world views both Christianity and God. How would the world look at Christians differently if we did fulfill our potential? How would they look at God differently?
